



players place seeds in each of the pits on the game board. a turn consists of removing all seeds from a pit, placing one in each of the following pits in sequence. the objective is to capture more seeds than the opponent. game variants include capturing holes, and thus all seeds sown on a captured hole belong at the end of the game to the player who captured it.
