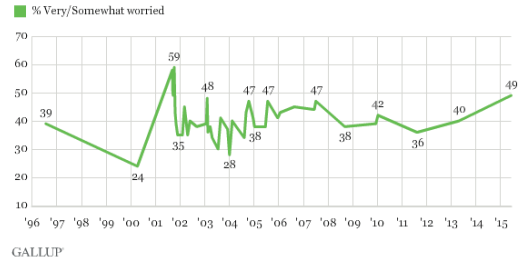
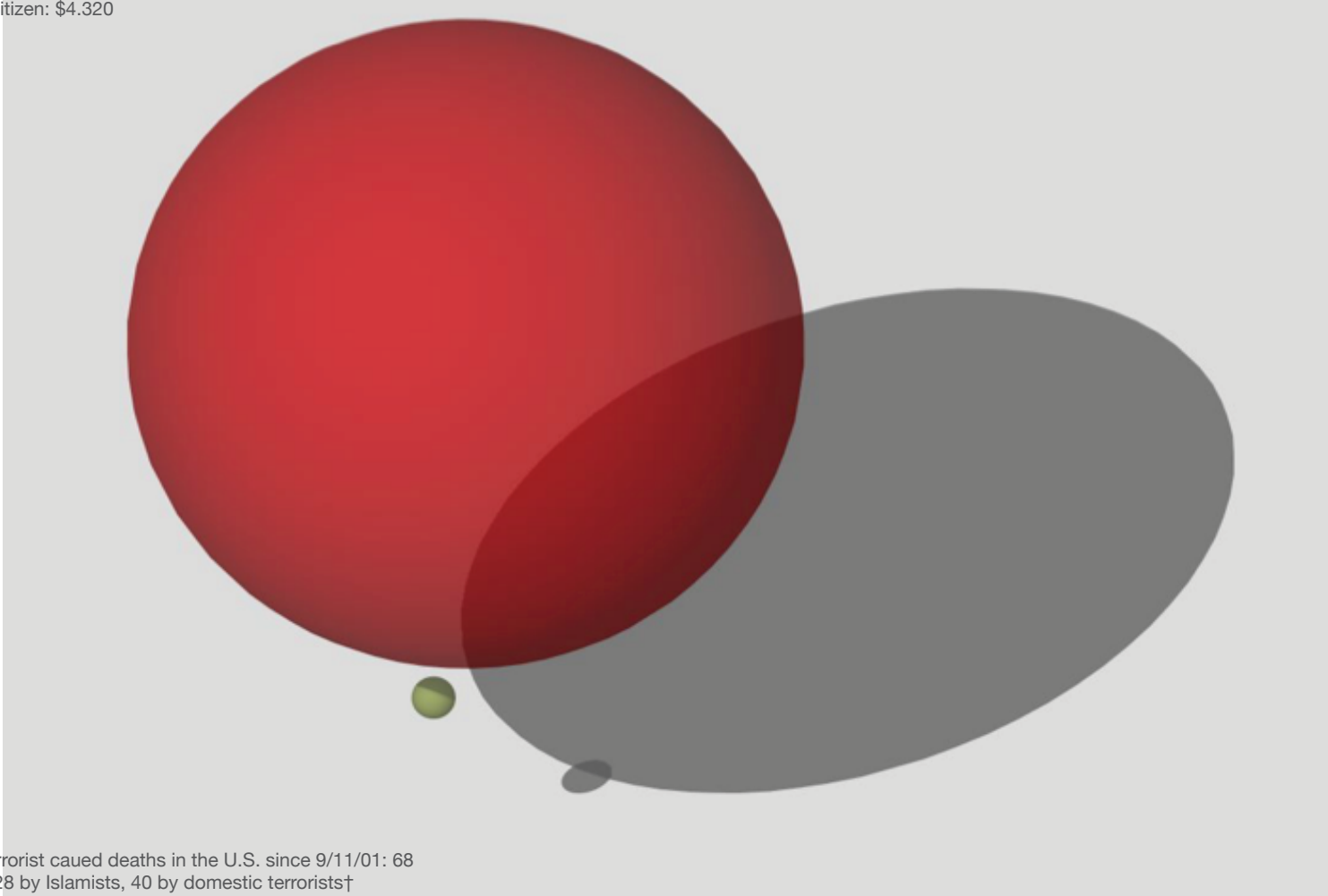


Worries About Becoming a Terrorism Victim Up in 2015

 cost per victim: \$ 6,875,000,000‡
 cost per citizen: \$1,498
